

OCTOBER – MONTH OF THE ROSARY



The Legion of Mary are inviting all families in the
parish to pray a daily decade of the Rosary during
October focusing on a set of mysteries each week.
This week we focus on the **Glorious Mysteries**.

First Glorious Mystery: The Resurrection. 'Why do you
seek the living among the dead? He is not here, He has
risen"' (Lk 24:5).

Second Glorious Mystery: The Ascension. "So then
the Lord Jesus, after he had spoken to them, was
taken up into heaven, and was seated at the right
hand of the Father." (Mk 16:19).

**Third Glorious Mystery: The Descent of the Holy
Spirit.** "They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and
began to speak in other tongues, as the Spirit gave
them the gift of speech." (Acts 2:4).

Fourth Glorious Mystery: The Assumption.
"Henceforth all generations will call me blessed; for he
who is mighty has done great things for me" (Lk 1:48-
49).

**Fifth Glorious Mystery: The Crowning of Our Lady
Queen of Heaven.** "And a great sign appeared in
heaven, a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon
under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve
stars" (Rev 12:1).



The Little Free Library



A Little Free Library is a **free book-sharing
box where anyone may take a book or
share a book.** Little Free Libraries can be
found in all manner of places, working on
the concept of 'take a book, return a book'. Users are also
encouraged to bring back another book to donate and
contribute to the collection. They can be placed outside or
inside your community house or centre.

Here at CRUN we want to promote the idea and to this end
we have funding to recruit eight female volunteers who
would be interested in learning the skills of wood working
while working on a little free library or 'honesty' box for
their local community building. You don't have to have any
