

OCTOBER - MONTH OF THE ROSARY



The Legion of Mary are inviting all families in the parish to pray a daily decade of the Rosary during October focusing on a set of mysteries each week. This week we focus on the **Glorious Mysteries**.

First Glorious Mystery: The Resurrection. 'Why do you seek the living among the dead? He is not here, He has risen"' (Lk 24:5).

Second Glorious Mystery: The Ascension. "So then the Lord Jesus, after he had spoken to them, was taken up into heaven, and was seated at the right hand of the Father." (Mk 16:19).

Third Glorious Mystery: The Descent of the Holy Spirit. "They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues, as the Spirit gave them the gift of speech." (Acts 2:4).

Fourth Glorious Mystery: The Assumption.

"Henceforth all generations will call me blessed; for he who is mighty has done great things for me" (Lk 1:48-

Fifth Glorious Mystery: The Crowning of Our Lady Queen of Heaven. "And a great sign appeared in heaven, a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars" (Rev 12:1).


