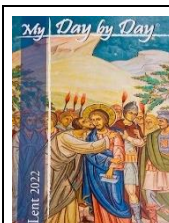

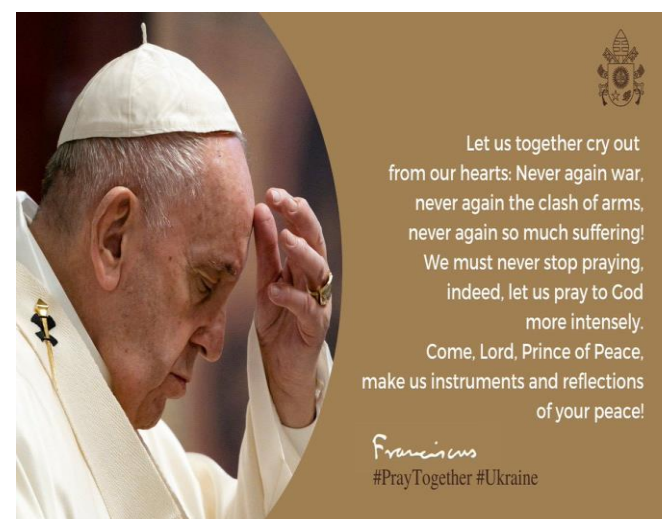

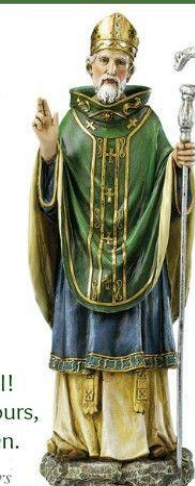
The Oversight Committee is anxious to raise
