All are welcome to join with our Polish community for Swieconka, the traditional blessing of Food on Easter **Saturday at 3pm in St Patricks.**

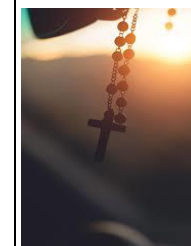
Swieconka is one of the most enduring and beloved Polish traditions. Baskets containing a sampling of Easter foods are brought to church to be blessed on Holy Saturday. The basket is traditionally lined with a white linen or lace napkin and decorated with sprigs of boxwood (bucszpan), the typical Easter evergreen. Observing the beautiful foods and creations of other parishioners is one of the special joys of the event.
