by Pope Francis for this year's celebration is: "In old
age they will still bear fruit" (Psalm 92:15).

on their faith to the next generation. The
announcement of a new Church-wide celebration for
Grandparents and the elderly came in answer to our
prayerful request to the Holy Father Pope Francis.

reassure them that they are loved and that they are
