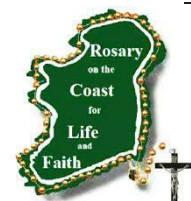


An Apostolic collection will be held

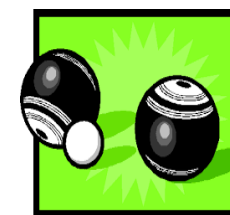
