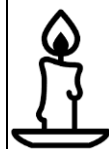

Envelopes for the November list of the Deceased are available at the back of the Church. When complete, please return to the basket in the front porch or to the parish office.



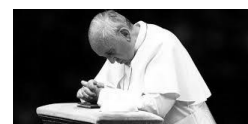
CHRISTMAS CARDS
