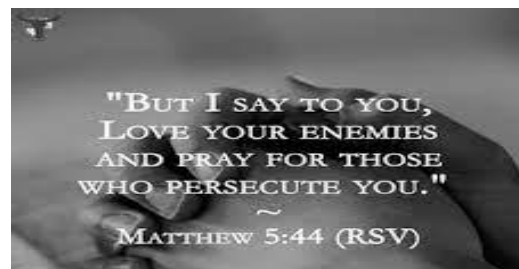

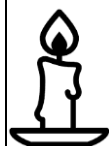

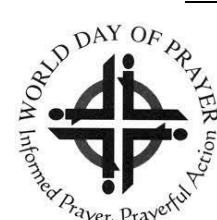

Choir.



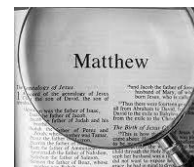
WARM SPACE
